All or part of the Work Session may be held in closed session under the authority of the State Open Meetings law by vote of the Commissioners. Certain topics may be considered an Administrative Function under the Open Meetings Act and therefore not subject to the terms of the Act.
- The Work Session topic list is subject to change up until the time of convening, and the order of items may change as time dictates or allows.
- Public comment/participation during topic discussions at a Work Session are at the discretion of the President.
