Certain topics may be considered an Administrative Function under the Open Meetings Act and therefore not subject to the terms of the Act.
- The Work Session topic list is subject to change up until the time of convening, and the order of items may change as time dictates or allows.
- Public comment/participation during topic discussions at a Work Session are at the discretion of the President.
