
Present: President Larry C. Porter, Wilbur Levensgood, Jr., Vice President; Daniel J. Franklin; Commissioner; and Chief of Staff Sara Visintainer

The Commissioners called the meeting to order at 8:05.

Discussion of Local State of Emergency: Chief of Staff, Sara Visintainer, stated that the Commissioners had signed Resolution #2018-027 Declaration of Local State of Emergency and Executive Order – Hurricane Florence, during the Commissioners meeting on the 12th of September. She stated that since the resolution was signed, the Caroline County Department of Emergency Services notified the office that the storm has changed paths and will most likely not have an impact on Caroline County. Ms. Visintainer stated that her recommendation would be to terminate the State of Emergency. The Commissioners stated that since the Governor had declared the State of Maryland in an emergency, they did not feel they should terminate the local emergency just in case the storm decided to change directions.

Staff was asked to keep the current local state of emergency in place.

There being no further discussion the commissioners adjourned their meeting at 8:45 p.m.
