I/We propose to furnish all labor, equipment, certain materials as stipulated herein and other items necessary and proper to complete work as directed for the **Caroline County Circuit Courthouse Masonry Brick Point Up Renovations** at the unit prices as stipulated above.

The Bidder agrees that this Proposal shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of 30 calendar days after the opening of the Bid Proposals.

The bid items listed above are intended to include all work items associated with a complete project, including mobilization. Some work components of the project may not be specifically listed and as such, it is the contractor’s responsibility to include all work required within an appropriate bid item listed above.

Caroline County, Maryland reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to award the Contract in total or in parts, which in their opinion, represents the best value and best serves the interest of **Caroline County, Maryland**.

ALL WORK UNDER THIS CONTRACT SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN COORDINATION WITH, AND AS DIRECTED BY, THE CAROLINE COUNTY DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS.

EXPLANATION OF SPECIFIC ITEMS

- A. Payment for all material furnished and work done under this Contract shall be made per the unit price bid for each item for the total quantity of the work completed, and per all applicable County and State specifications attributable to each bid item. The Contractor shall not be entitled to receive additional

compensation for anything furnished or done, except for such extra work authorized in writing by the Engineer.

- B. **Items 1 through 4** - The bid price for all items shall include full compensation for all labor, materials, equipment, tools and incidentals necessary to complete all work as described. Specific items are further defined as follows by bid item number:

Item 1: Removal of the existing brick facade's stretcher course mortar utilizing air chisels/grinders, etc., to a maximum depth of 3/4" or to sound mortar.

Item 2: Removal of all head joints is to be performed without use of mechanical equipment

Item 3: All exposed mortar joints are to be cleaned and the mortar pointed back to match the existing mortar color

Item 4: Upon completion of the pointing, the wall is to be cleaned with a water as required to provide the appropriate surface finish. A mild acid solution may be used in lieu of water

CONTINGENCY ITEMS

- A. Items listed as CONTINGENCY ITEMS in the Proposal may be used and will be paid for only at the written direction and authorization of the Engineer. Contingency items may be selected in place of, or in addition to, the standard bid items. Such selections to be authorized by the Engineer in writing. All materials furnished and installed shall be in accordance with County and State specifications. Measurements and payment will be in accordance with the proposal and will include but not necessarily be limited to the furnishing, hauling, placing and installing of materials, and the furnishing of such manpower and equipment as required to accomplish the work as directed in writing by the Engineer.
- B. Contingency bid items are to be measured and paid for in accordance with the units shown in the Proposal. The contingency item prices shall be applied in computing the value of changes, additions, deletions and substitutions, which may be made in the work and by order of the Engineer. Each unit price shall include the cost for all labor, materials, tools, equipment, overhead, profits, and commissions necessary to complete the item. The stipulated items are defined as follows:

Item 1 All mortar joints within portions of section 1 shall be 100 % ground and tuck pointed in its entirety, as specified in the original specifications. All grinding and tuck pointing shall comply with OSHA standards including but not limited to vacuum grinding
